2011 ANNUAL STREET LIGHTING REVIEW

In accordance with Policy RM.11 – Street Lighting

MAINTENANCE

The Public Works department has been monitoring street lights for damages and outages and has been responding to citizen's complaints in this regard.

Complaints are immediately reported by the Public Works Office to BC Hydro's Street Light Information Management Program (SLIM). BC Hydro then has a ten-day work window, in which they carry out the necessary repairs.

COLUMBIA CRESENT UPGRADE

The decorative street lighting in Columbia Crescent has been an issue for some time now. The lamp standards are noisy, the lighting is yellow and replacement parts are impossible to come by. This year, we are in the process of retrofitting the entire subdivision with new lamp standards, equipped with photo cells. This will vastly improve the effectiveness, cost efficiency and esthetics of street lighting in this area.

FUTURE INSTALLATIONS

Lighting along the waterfront walkway would be beneficial. A grant proposal was previously submitted by the Arena/Parks Manager, unfortunately, this project was unsuccessful in obtaining funds.
