

MAINTENANCE

The Public Works department has been monitoring street lights for damages and outages and has been responding to citizen’s complaints in this regard. The decorative street lights in Columbia Crescent are the responsibility of the Village to maintain. There have been several repairs completed in this area this year.

Complaints of damage and outages of BC Hydro street lights are reported by the Public Works Office, which are then entered into the BC Hydro Street Light Information Management Program (SLIM). It is then up to BC Hydro to schedule and execute the repairs. In 2015 the following complaints were logged:
