



STAGE 1 WATERING RESTRICTIONS IMPLEMENTED

On Friday, September 15, 2017 the Village was advised that the Province has moved the regional drought classification level to a level 3 (very dry) for the East Kootenay, West Kootenay and Lower Columbia regions. They advised that although there has been a significant decrease in temperatures, there is still little precipitation in the forecast which has been a driver in this change in the drought level. This continued limited precipitation in our region leaves many of our streams showing low to very low water levels.

In order to comply with the Provincial request for reduced consumption of water, **effective immediately**, the Village is implementing Stage 1 watering restrictions as follows:

- ***Underground sprinklering is only permitted between 12:00 a.m. & 2:00 a.m.***
- ***Lawn and garden sprinklering is only permitted from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on permitted days (i.e. even numbered civic addresses on even numbered dates and odd numbered civic address on odd numbered dates; no watering on the 31st of any month).***
- ***No hosing/washing of driveways, sidewalks, patios, or vehicles is permitted.***

The Stage 1 watering restrictions will remain in effect until further notice. We thank everyone for their co-operation.
