Nomination forms are available at the Nakusp Village Office from 8:00 am Friday, May 9, 2019 to 4:00 pm June 7, 2019 (closing of the nomination period).

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day July 13, 2019;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;
- a person or the commander of an armed forces unit who has been granted freedom of the municipality, if that person is a Canadian citizen; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2019 local by-election election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Councillor \$ 5,000

Campaign Period: June 8, 2019 to July 13, 2019

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2019 local by-election, the following third-party advertising limits apply:

Councillor \$750
