We ask that residents have all yard waste ready for May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

This is in the interest of maintaining public health and safety. The Nakusp Hot Springs, the Arena, and the Village Offices are now closed to public access. We are in the process of notifying anyone that has a booking for any of our facilities. If you wish to make a payment, there are options available. You can mail a cheque, drop off payment in drop slot at Village Office, or pay online if your banking institution offers this option with the Village. We will keep you updated as things progress and hope that you remain healthy and safe.
