**2021 CIP/AAP Intake Period: January 4, 2021 to February 26, 2021**

#### **ONLINE APPLICATION SYSTEM**

Wish to apply for project funding? The Regional District of Central Kootenay will be accepting project proposal applications for 2021 Community Initiatives and Affected Areas Program Funding (CIP/AAP) consideration from non-profit organizations, societies, and groups throughout the RDCK *through the Trust's online application system.*

#### **WHO CAN APPLY?**

Eligible applicants include registered and non-registered non-profits, Indigenous organizations, registered schools, and local government. Proposals need to adhere to the spirit of programs provided by the Trust and support efforts by the people in the Basin for meeting community and public need rather than private needs. CIP/AAP funding is to be used to support proposals that provide additional value for the public good and to assist communities in achieving their collective priorities.

#### **HOW TO APPLY? – On-line Applications will be accepted January 4 thru February 26, 2021 at 4:30 pm.**

Organizations are encouraged to carefully read through the 2021 Pre-Application Worksheet and Application Guide for application information and instructions.

You will need to create an account to access the CIP/AAP program application form first. Once an account is created, organizations are able to complete the online application and further edit the submitted application up to the deadline date of February 26, 2021 at 4:30 p.m..

- When logged into a CBT account, organizations will only be able to work on one draft application at a time. Organizations must save and submit an application before they can begin another online application.
- Submitted applications can be edited up until the submission deadline (February 26, 2021 at 4:30 pm).

Copies of the Pre-Application Worksheet and Application Guide will be made available in hard copy to Area Directors; RDCK Services at the Creston Library; the Lardeau Community Centre; City, Town and Village offices throughout the Regional District; and at the RDCK head office in Nelson commencing January 2021.
