Residents are asked to stay clear of snow clearing equipment, please give our operators at least 30m (100ft) of room when working.

Per Village Bylaw 496 residents may not park on the roadside from November 15<sup>th</sup> – April 1<sup>st</sup>, vehicles impeding snow clearing may be towed.

## Outstanding Utility or Property Tax Bills?

It's not too late to apply for your 2022 Home Owner Grant if you haven't done so already. Apply online at [www.gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant](http://www.gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant), by phone at **1-888-355-2700**, or in person at a Service BC location. If you forgot to apply for your Home Owner Grant last year, you may be eligible to receive a Retroactive Home Owner Grant. The grant may be approved for the previous year only.

Current year unpaid taxes will be in arrears on January 1, 2023 and will begin incurring interest charges. Unpaid utility bills will be transferred to arrears taxes on January 1, 2023 and begin incurring interest charges. A 10% penalty was applied to all unpaid current year taxes on July 5<sup>th</sup> and all unpaid utility bills on September 1<sup>st</sup>. If you require your current outstanding balance, please contact the Village office.
